RE: Unexpected and Suspicious Death Of My Sister, Joyce B. (Strouse)
Sauter, [REDACTED]

Dear COL. Fuentes,

I am writing this letter to you to obtain your help in learning what is going on with the investigation into my sister Joyce's death. I am asking you for help because neither I nor my sister Carolyn Ausley [REDACTED] both former NJ residents, have been able to get anyone we know to be involved with the investigation, to share any information with us. I understand we have no "legal standing" in NJ. And now in her death, apparently, neither does Joyce.

Joyce B. (Strouse) Sauter, weak, disoriented, and bed-ridden at the time of her death, would have turned 62 on November 9, 2005. Although diagnosed with terminal cancer, the cancer appeared to have been in remission at the time of her death, based on PET scan results. I believe Joyce was killed by [REDACTED] on the evening of October 29, 2005. In fact, he told me personally that the plan was for Joyce to die, not live. I believe that [REDACTED] either suffocated her, over-dosed her on pain medication, or starved her to death, or some combination of all three, over the last three months of her life. My allegations were made to the Sayreville, NJ, police on October 29, 2005, to a LT Brenner. Subsequently I provided a telephone statement to a Det-Sgt Jeff Sprague. Neither have returned any of my calls.

Enclosed you will find extensive and significant correspondence regarding concerns expressed by my sister Carolyn Ausley and me. We have been in touch with a number of Middlesex County authorities, mostly
