3 this matter, Carolyn [redacted] Ausley.

4 Now, it's interesting that Ms. Ausley's ap-
5 plication is also supported by a certification from --
6 from the decedent's brother, and it's also interesting
7 that the -- that law enforcement has consistently fail-
8 ed to take any action, notwithstanding the allegations
9 of -- of the -- of the plaintiff in this matter.

10 I don't see the harm that cannot be remedied
11 if in fact there are slanderous allegations made as to
12 the defendant in this matter, as to [redacted] I
13 think that these specimens will be destroyed. There
14 are no -- there is no indication that, by the defendant
15 -- that there is a desire on his part to keep them for
16 any sentimental reason. There's nothing set forth in
17 defendant's papers regarding the same.

18 I do -- I do agree with the inference in
19 [redacted] -- [redacted] certification that -- that this
20 will prolong any idea of closure on the part of those
21 who were closest to the decedent and, clearly, she was
22 close to the decedent. But when I weigh the harm to
23 either side with regard to a mere sampling of these --
24 of these specimens, and when I look at the -- when I
25 look at the fact that they will be destroyed by the
