I don't see the harm that cannot be remedied 10 11 if in fact there are slandarous sllegations made as to 12 the defendant in this matter, as to 13 think that these specimens will be destroyed. There 14 are no -- there is no indication that, by the defendant 15 -- that there is a desire on his part to keep them for 16 any sentimental reason. There's nothing set forth in 17 defendant's papers regarding the same. I do -- I do agree with the inference in 18 certification that -- that this 19 20 will prolong any idea of closure on the part of those 21 who were closest to the decadent and, clearly, she was 22 close to the decedent.
