SUBJECT: Complaint Against Frederick J. DiCarlo, Assistant Medical Examiner,
Middlesex County, New Jersey

Dear Ms. Milgram:



This complaint is filed against Dr. DiCarlo for violation of numerous criminal laws surrounding the suspicious death investigation of our sister, Joyce B. (Strouse) Sauter, who died on October 29, 2005. This complaint is related to the complaints we filed against the First Deputy Counsel of Middlesex County and the Prosecutor of Middlesex County, which you received in mid-February 2008.



We request that your office conduct the appropriate investigations of these individuals and that you keep us informed of the status of the investigations. We are available with reasonable notice to meet with you regarding the complaints.

In offering his opinion in part of the litigation leading up to these complaints, Judge Travis L. Francis of the Superior Court of New Jersey wondered why "law enforcement consistently failed to take any action ... not withstanding the allegations ... of the plaintiff in this matter."¹

An opportunity to rectify a wrong is now before you. We request that Dr. DiCarlo be prosecuted to the full extent of the law. We look forward to hearing from you soon. Please confirm receipt of this complaint.
