She stated that her [REDACTED] and herself did everything they could and she stated that she did not go to work while she was tending to her mother's care and she understands that the family was not happy, she had recently changed her phone number because of the harassing phone calls from her relatives. She stated she could not take it any longer and she changed her phone number so they would not be able to call her and harass her any further in reference to her mother's passing. This officer asked if she would give a statement in reference to her mother's hospice death and she stated yes she would. A statement was taken by this officer and Det. Noble on 12-27-05 beginning at 1422 hours and concluding at 1437 hours. For further information, see statement. It should also be noted that based on the allegations of abuse by [REDACTED] which could have occurred during the juvenile years or young adult years of the daughters, this officer requested Capt. Szkodny to check the juvenile records to see if any calls or incidents had occurred at that address regarding any type of abuse being reported by family members. Capt. Szkodny did check the juvenile records and did not locate any reports regarding any type of abuse occurring at [REDACTED] or anything involving [REDACTED]
