- A. I was led to believe they thought she was overmedicated.
- Q. Okay. Okay. And to your knowledge, did you ever see anything that was being done to your mother that you were concerned about?
- A. No.
- Q. Did any nurses ever bring it to your attention, their concerns?
- A. No.
- Q. Okay. Have you ever made any doctor visits with your mom?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Okay. And your mom was aware of her difficult situation in reference to her health?
- A. Yes.
- Q. Okay. Did your mother smoke?
- A. Yes.
- Q. How many years, do you know?
- A. 44.
- Q. Okay. And just prior to your mom passing, were you told that her passing was gonna be soon?
