What did [REDACTED] do when he saw Joyce getting more and more emaciated and dehydrated each day? Anything? Did he contact any of the doctors? What did they say? There should be a note in Joyce's medical record to that end. Which doctors said what? When did [REDACTED] contact them and when did they say it? Why didn't [REDACTED] contact any of the doctors when he saw Joyce losing all her weight? Especially if he concluded it was because of giving her all the meds? [REDACTED] refused advice offered by both me and Carolyn Ausley. After a somewhat heated conversation regarding diet and meds on October 25, 2005, [REDACTED] said to me, "What is, is. What is will be. And that is that. Goodbye." If you want someone to die, you don't raise a red flag, do you?

Suffocation:

I imagine only the medical examiner can address this issue. There are protocols to follow to make this determination. This determination must be made. At the time of Joyce's death, [REDACTED] told me he was the only one in the house. [REDACTED] told me he gave Joyce some pain meds at 1630 hours and when he went back in Joyce's room at 1700 hours to give her more pain meds, she was dead. You might inquire as to why he was going back in 30 minutes later to give additional pain meds? He was the only one in the house. [REDACTED] had stepped out he said, and Hospice was not there, he said. There was his window of opportunity.

Motive:

Per the email from [REDACTED] dated Aug 2 (you all have copies) [REDACTED] brutally abused both [REDACTED] and Joyce for many years. [REDACTED] also believes [REDACTED] continued the abuse long after she left, and as recently as August 2004 in particular. Read [REDACTED] email. [REDACTED] enjoyed inflicting pain on women and kids, right up to the end,
