Finally, on behalf of Dr. DiCarlo, I wish to clarify a couple of statements which are made in the Verified Complaint. In paragraph 19, Plaintiff states that Dr. DiCarlo "did not perform an autopsy even though he knew that the Sayreville Police had put him on Notice that the death was alleged to be suspicious". The fact is that the Sayreville Police Report did not report Ms. Sauter's death as suspicious.

Paragraph 24 of the Verified Complaint suggests that Dr. DiCarlo did not perform all tests that he might have. Complete available toxicology testing was performed by Dr. DiCarlo.

To reiterate, neither Middlesex County, the Middlesex County Medical Examiner's office nor Dr. Frederick DiCarlo oppose the entry of an Order by Your Honor which authorizes the release of the tissue samples to Plaintiff.
