Dear Dr. DiCarlo:

Thank you for your response letter dated April 28<sup>th</sup>. As I understand your short letter your office has a policy regarding the release of toxicological specimens in that you require a court order. As you are already aware the family of Joyce Sauter, date of death 10/29/05, has requested my assistance in evaluating this death.

New Jersey Administrative Code 13:49-3.1 provides for the release of autopsy specimens to the requester if the requester can demonstrate proper interest. In this case Carolyn Ausley, and Bill Strauss, the decedent's sister and brother, respectively, have demonstrated proper interest in obtaining the toxicological specimens, which your office no longer requires, in that your investigation of the death is completed.

Respectively, under the Freedom of Information Act, I would ask that you provide me a copy of your office's policy, in place, at the time of the death if different from your policy today, regarding the requirements of a court order for release of said autopsy and toxicological specimens to other interested parties. I also request that you provide me the state statute that you are invoking to bypass your state's Administrative Code.
